GENERAL USE & CARE GUIDE

EDL Laminates are manufactured with aesthetics and durability in mind. When used as recommended and with appropriate care, our laminates will last through the years. EDL Laminates are easy to maintain.

GENERAL TIPS

- Do not place hot cookware directly on the laminate. Prolonged exposure to temperatures above
 60 degrees Celsius may cause damage to the laminate surface.
- Do not use the laminate for purposes that it is not intended for. (E.g. do not iron, chop, hammer or expose the laminate to open flame.)
- Laminates are suitable for indoor use only. Outdoor applications with exposure to direct sunlight and weather conditions are not recommended.
- UV rays may alter the colour of the laminate.
- Gloss surfaces are recommended only for vertical applications.

CLEANING

- Cleaning should be done with water and a clean, non-abrasive cloth.
- Use mild household cleansers or detergents to gently wipe down. Avoid the use of abrasive liquid cleansers, bleaching compounds or solutions as these may damage the surface of the laminate.
- Dry the surface with a clean, non-abrasive cloth.
